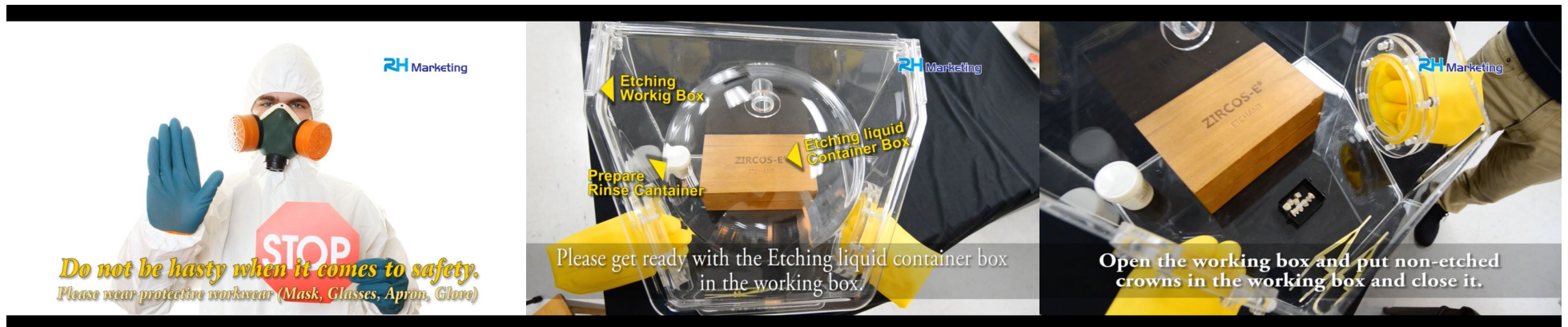


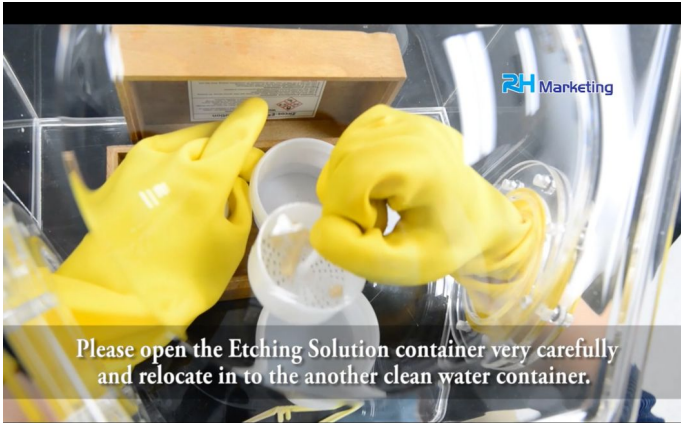

2HR PREFERENCE INSTRUCTIONS

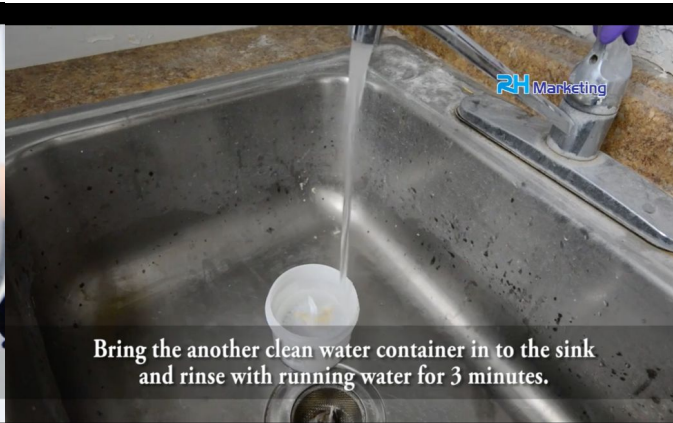




Please open the Etching Solution container very carefully and relocate in to the another clean water container.



Please make sure your left over Etching Solution container is closed tight for next time use.



Bring the another clean water container in to the sink and rinse with running water for 3 minutes.



Please clean the etched crowns with steamer.



Finally, please degas the etched crowns using porcelain furnace with glaze program.

ZIRCOS-E Etching Solution
 (Contains Hydrofluoric Acid (HF), Hydrogen Chloride (HCl), Sulfuric Acid (H₂SO₄),
 Nitric Acid (HNO₃), Phosphoric Acid (H₂PO₄))



May intensify fire. May be fatal if swallowed and enters airways.

IF ON SKIN (or hair): Remove or take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water or shower.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing.

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.
